TRAIL RIDING RULES & REGULATIONS

Horseback riding is a dangerous activity. Horses are unpredictable.
Participation in this activity is at your own risk

- All riders must be *at least* **seven (7) years of age or older**.
- For the safety of both the rider and the horse, all riders must be at least 4 feet tall and weigh less than 230 lbs. This is strictly enforced.
- All riders must be able to demonstrate the ability to mount the horse from the ground
- Closed toed shoes and long pants must be worn on the trail and while at the facility
- All riders must wear an equestrian rated helmet.
As of July 1 2021, this rule will be strictly enforced
- Please do not feed the horses; do not worry – they already eat plenty!
- Absolutely no alcohol on the premises. For your safety, we reserve the right to refuse service or cancel your ride if you are determined to be under the influence.
- We love dogs, but our horses unfortunately do not. Please, no dogs on the premises.

TRAIL RIDING RULES & REGULATIONS

- Children must be closely supervised at all times.
- Stay with your trail riding group at all times.
- We ride to the speed of the slowest rider. Please, no riding ahead.
- No loping, cantering, or galloping at any time
- Please be gentle with the horses
- Monteverde Equestrian Center is a private facility. Please refrain from wandering outside of trail riding waiting area
- Horses are very aware of your feelings. If you are nervous, they'll be nervous. If you are afraid of horses, please consider canceling your ride.
- No smoking or vaping at or around the facility. This is wildfire country.
- Please use the large barrel trash cans for any waste. No littering.
